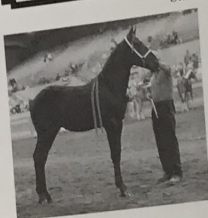
Scholarships are paid directly to the school and grade-point averages must be met and maintained. You can find a printable application under Education Fund from our web site, www.percheronhorse.org.

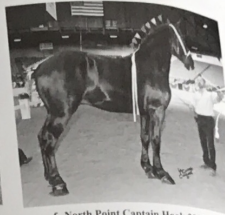

Diamonds In The Rough

Ask any owner of the Percheron breed what colors you can find these horses in and they'll likely tell you time and again that they only come in black and grey. The reality is that the majority of owners and participants in the breed are misinformed. The Percheron breed is still allowed to be registered in 41 different variations of color by the American Association. The Percheron Horse Association of America is one of the few registries for the Percheron breed worldwide that still allow all color variations of the Percheron to be recognized, registered, and documented.

Percherons knowingly come in Black, Grey, Chestnut, Blue Roan, Bay Roan, Red Roan, Sorrel, Bay, and Brown. Some of these variations no longer exist within the breed at this time simply because it is not one of the things that most are focusing on. Some of these variations could be bred back into the breed with the right genetics at play and small bits of luck. Every single breeder of Percherons breeds for color even if it's Black and Grey, why not have breeders who specialize in something Dream Percherons and Hacienda Percherons is trying to accomplish. By joining knowledge, resources and horses, I and my parents, Pat and Marie Winn of Remus, Michigan is doing exactly that. I call it preservation because at this point this is what is being done. We are trying to breed for certain characteristics and colors before they disappear completely from the breed.

In 2003 I was sent on a mission to find a blue roan Percheron stallion after seeing the color listed as a choice on the Percheron Horse Association website. I truly didn't realize how unbelievably lucky I was to come across such a stallion so quickly and so easily. When I first initiated my search I came across a large majority of cross-breeds who as registered color but definitely didn't qualify as registered purebred Percherons. An off handed comment

in a chat room led to "somebody who knew somebody". A connection from California all the way to Virginia would lead me to exactly what I was looking for, a blue roan stallion available for sale. We didn't have the stallion for more than a year but he started something for me specifically. I wasn't involved firsthand with the Percheron breed. I simply was another horse owner with a passion for pedigree researching and equine color genetics. By 2005 I purchased my first Percheron mare, black, and bred her to that specific stallion. She ended up producing me a black filly in 2006 that I wished were roan in the worst way. Even though the blue roan stallion went on to another program I continued to work on documenting roan within the Percheron breed with the help of the online studbook offered by the Association. My basic knowledge of how roan worked truly helped me do this. All I needed was a starting point to start researching horses, which was the stallion my mother had owned.

One must first understand how the roan gene works. Roan, like grey, is a gene that requires one parent to be that color for it to exist. It cannot skip a generation. So if I horse is not roan then it will never produce it no matter how many times it is in the horse's ancestry. Roan and grey in the Percheron breed actually have an interesting relationship. While two completely different genes that both behave in a different manner other than involving white hair, in many horses they have run alongside each other for generations. Many who have owned roans in the past have bred them to grey horses potentially believing their roans were grey. Others have bred roan horses to grey horses in hopes of hiding the color. Grey is truly the gene responsible for saving these less common colors due to its natural color erasing abilities. Grey is a gene that erases color with time that eventually turns a horse white. Any color of horse can be affected by the gene producing one parent passed it on.

If a horse does carry a grey gene it will take the original color with time. Genetically these horses are still the original color they were born as but grey masks that. When typically bred to other black Percherons these horses would occasionally produce a non-graying foal that also exhibited a less common color. A perfect example of this would be the mare W.V. Mariah (268640). Mariah had produced eight registered foals in her lifetime. A mare whom was both blue roan and grey, time erasing any visual indicators of her roan coloration. Four of her eight foals I know beyond a shadow of doubt were blue roan. Of that four, one was blue roan plus grey. Of the four remaining other foals, two of those foals were possibly roan but unknown as they were registered as grey and I was never able to find more information on them. How this comes together is that W.V. Mariah was the dam of W.V. White Lightning (275177), the stallion I had found back in 2004. This information would come in handy when I was again asked to find a blue roan Percheron stallion in 2012. The downside is by 2012 I realized how rare blue roan Percherons were. I had only three known stallions of breeding age, intact and living documented in the United States. A phone call turned up that W.V. White Lightning was deceased a few years prior. I hunted down Mariah's remaining blue roan son and jointly acquired Maple Grove's Gamblers Ace (288843) with my mother, Marie Winn. Ace is now the foundation of our breeding programs. Roan is a very small gene pool with three stallions documented in the United States, one blue roan + grey stallion, and three upcoming blue roan colts. While I have not officially counted up the number of
