Percheron Youth Power:

The Percheron Youth Power program allows a PHAoA Youth Member to showcase their talents in the show ring and other competitions. Youth will earn points for their placings at competitive events in the categories listed below. Each category will be split into two aged-based divisions; 9-14 years old and 15-18 years old. Eligible competitions include state and county fairs, 4-H shows, open shows, plowing matches, and versatility shows. Categories may be expanded as needed by the Youth Membership Committee. Age of youth is based on their age as of January 1st of the year of competition.

• Team	• Decorating	• Obstacle

There must be a minimum of three entries in a class for a youth to be awarded points for a class placing. Placings from Danish judging are not eligible for points. Points will be earned as follows:

5 or more entries:	4 entries:	3 entries:
1 st – 5 points	1 st – 4 points	1 st – 3 points
2 nd – 4 points	2 nd – 3 points	2 nd – 2points
3 rd – 3 points	3 rd – 2 points	3 rd 1 point
4 th – 2 points	4 th – 1 point	
5 th – 1 point		

Youth will complete a show report that must be signed by a show's official to verify placings that a youth is requesting points for. Points will be awarded when report is received by the Association office. Each show must have a separate report, but multiple reports may be submitted together.

The Percheron Youth Power program year will be October 1 to September 30.

End of the Year Awards:

The top point earning participant in each category per age will receive a plaque and ribbon. Places 2-5 will receive a ribbon.

The top 5 overall points earning participants per age will be awarded. Prizes will vary from year to year and will be announced by September 1st.

Youth will be presented with their awards at the Annual Members' Meeting and Banquet.
